<p>Discussion and action points agreed from current SEG monitoring enquiry:</p> <p>Planning for next monitoring enquiry:</p>	<p>Christian Vision and Distinctiveness</p> <p>Work is ongoing to ensure the School's vision is clear and embedded across the community. KW and LB have met to discuss terminology and establish a shared vision aligned with the School SEF. Pupils have also had opportunities to reflect on the School's values and explore the vision.</p> <p>Reflection on Monitoring</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pupils initially did not understand the word "justice." Once the meaning was explained, they were able to articulate their own understanding of justice and its relevance to them. Pupils demonstrated a strong awareness of charitable events and how they could contribute to helping others. An in-depth discussion was held with pupils across the School. Pupils were less confident in making curriculum links with justice and responsibility.
