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Dear Parents & Carers

The sun is shining, and the children are smiling! It's Comic Relief Day today and we are all wearing "something funny for money". The three children who were awarded a first prize by the judges were: Jo, Anna and William- well done to everyone involved you were all fantastic- so brave and confident!

The children have raised **£91.80** as a result of their fund -raising ideas today! They have also continued their drive to raise money for the children of Ukraine and have raised £55.00 already which they plan to donate to Save the Children who are working to support refugees. This week they installed a jar for spare coppers and small change in the school entrance and a very artistic fund -raising scale on the wall to track their achievement.

This week we launched the idea of having a *Word of the Week* and Honeywell children were the first to really engage with the idea. As a result a number of the children have independently used the word *scrutiny/scrutinise* in their writing. They were also seen eating hot cross buns which were being used as maths resources for learning in fractions. Mrs Billington helped them to create a fantastic dance and once we get a copy of the DVD we will be able to share it with you if you weren't able to see them in person.
